Course Description: this course orients the student to the anatomical scientific terms and structure of the human body.

Organization of human body, directional terms, body cavities, types of tissues, types of bones, classification of skeletal system, structure of alimentary tract and biliary system, external and internal structure of the heart, and blood vessels, blood circulation and lymphatic system.
