Call for papers

Original research papers will be accepted and these should be submitted as full length paper with an abstract not exceeding 250 words. These should be submitted in word file, through e-mail. Acceptance for papers will be sent through e- mail also subject to approval by the Scientific Committee

Papers should be submitted by only those researchers or practitioners who intend to participate. Scientists, researchers, academics and post graduate students who do not intend to present any paper but likes to participate in the conference are also welcome

Paper Submission:

Authors are invited to submit original papers in English.

All submitted papers will be peer refereed for relevance, originality, and correctness.

The Scientific committee reserves the right to accept a submission as either a paper or poster presentation. As a guideline for the paper the length should not exceed 7000 words typeset in a 12-point font in Microsoft Word. All accepted papers will be published in the SUST Journal of Camel Research and production. All papers submission will be handled electronically.

Oral or Poster Presentation Times New Roman 11pt (Please indicate).

Abstract: Times New Roman 12pt. 250 words (word count excludes Title and Author details).

Abstracts must be written in English,

Keywords: Times New Roman 12pt italics 3-5 Keywords.

Formatting the abstract: This document is an example of the preferred style to be used to format the abstract for submission to the (ISCCRP, 2017)

Title of the paper (Heading1)

The title should be in Times New Roman font 12 point bold, in sentence case (only the first word and proper nouns capitalized).

Leave 2 blank lines after the title.

Author details: Author details are centered and should be provided as follows: author/s names on the first line in Times New Roman 12point bold (style: Author). The name of the presenting author should be underlined. The presenting authors' organization and address should be on the following lines in plain text, Times New Roman, 11 point (style: Affiliation) as indicated by the superscript number 1 after the author's name. Where the address details of co-authors differ to the presenting author, these details should be on a separate line, and be indicated by a superscript number after the authors' names. See example below:

Page setup: Use A4 paper size settings and use 2.5 cm margins all around, that is: Top 2.5 cm, Bottom 2.5 cm, Left 2.5 cm, Right 2.5 cm. Leave the Gutter at 0cm. Headers, footers and page numbers. Ensure that your document does not include headers, footers or page numbers, as these will be added later for the publication. Footnotes: Do not use footnotes in your abstract. Presentation Instructions:

Oral Presentation Instructions: Each talk is 15 minutes long. It is recommended to use 12 minutes to present and 3 minutes to discuss. The recommended software to be used is PowerPoint.

Poster Presentation Instructions: Poster sessions will provide an opportunity for the authors to display the results and conclusions of their papers. Dimensions and format:

- Posters should be printed and brought by each author to the conference.
- The poster can be up to 120 cm high x 90 cm wide. (47.24 inches high x 35½ inches wide).
- The poster should be readable from a distance of 2 meters.
